FIRST HEARING FOR THE INQUIRY INTO ANTISEMITISM IN NEW SOUTH WALES

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE 14 May 2025

The NSW Legislative Council's Portfolio Committee No. 5 – Justice and Communities will hold its first hearing for the inquiry into antisemitism in New South Wales on Monday 19 May 2025.

The committee will hear from a range of individuals and organisations, including representative bodies of the Jewish, Arab and Muslim communities, community groups, academics, the Sydney Jewish Museum, and Great Synagogue.

The Chair of the committee, Hon Robert Borsak MLC said: "The committee has received submissions from a range of stakeholders addressing the inquiry's term of reference, including the causes of antisemitic incidents, antisemitism on university campuses, and the threat to social cohesion presented by antisemitism."

Mr Borsak continued: "The committee looks forward to hearing directly from some of these stakeholders about the prevalence of these issues and how they might be addressed."
